

Modem Setup Instructions

NBN FTTN Connection



Step 1:

Plug modem into computer with the yellow cable supplied. Plug it into the yellow plug on the modem labelled **Eth. 1**

Step 2:

Open up your internet browser on your computer and use 192.168.20.1 as the URL.

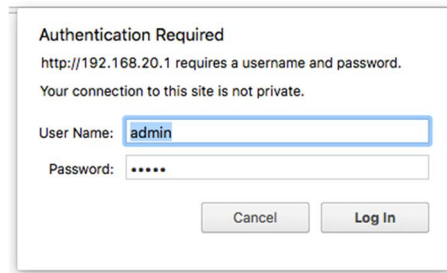


Step 3:

When prompted enter the following

User Name: admin

Password: admin



Step 4:

Click on "Management" from the menu on the left.



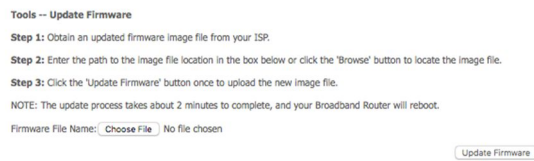
Step 5:

Click on the "Choose File" Button

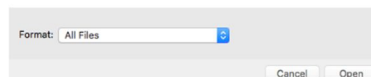


Step 7:

Select the correct file to upload



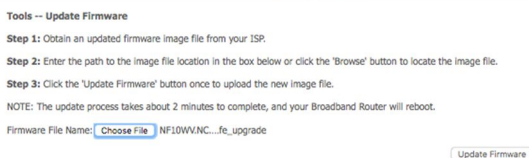
Then click on "Open"

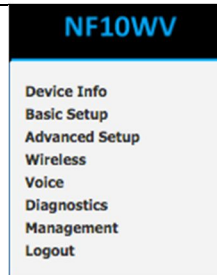
Step 9:

Once it's loaded the new firmware, the first page should look like this, with the Software Version in the Device Info being the file you just uploaded. (If not, try from Step 4 again).

Step 10:
