These instructions are to help you configure your router for IPv6. Please note that different firmware versions and models of routers may have slightly different configurations.

Firmware Version Tested: 1.5.4 Build 210818 Rel.58812n(4555)

Connection Type: PPPoE - Ethernet

1. Open a web browser, such as Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox, type <http://router.asus.com> or <http://192.168.1.1> into the address bar, and press **Enter**.
2. Log in using the password you have previously set, if you cant remember try **admin**.
3. Once logged in, select **Advanced** from the menu on the top, and then click **IPv6**. Configure the connection as below and then click **connect** or **save**.

- Mode: **Router**
- WAN Connection Type: **Normal**
- Get IPv6 Address: **Auto**
- Manually set DNS server: **NO**
- Enable Prefix Delegation: **YES**
