## Installation:

Someone over the age of 18 must be home during the appointment window for any appointments. This upgrade usually takes 2 appointments, with the first scheduled directly by nbntm.

The install may require trenching and installation of new conduit depending on the condition and capacity of existing access paths.

It is possible that customers might be liable some costs if there is additional works required for the installation that are out of scope.
